RoHS stands for the "restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment". This European Directive aims to control the use of the following hazardous substances:

Lead
Cadmium
Hexavalent Chromium
PBB – polybrominated biphenyl
PBDE – polybrominated diphenyl ether
Mercury

RoHS Regulations require that product must not contain the hazardous substances above the maximum concentration values.

Amstek Metal requires our Suppliers to certify that all of their materials conform to this requirement.
